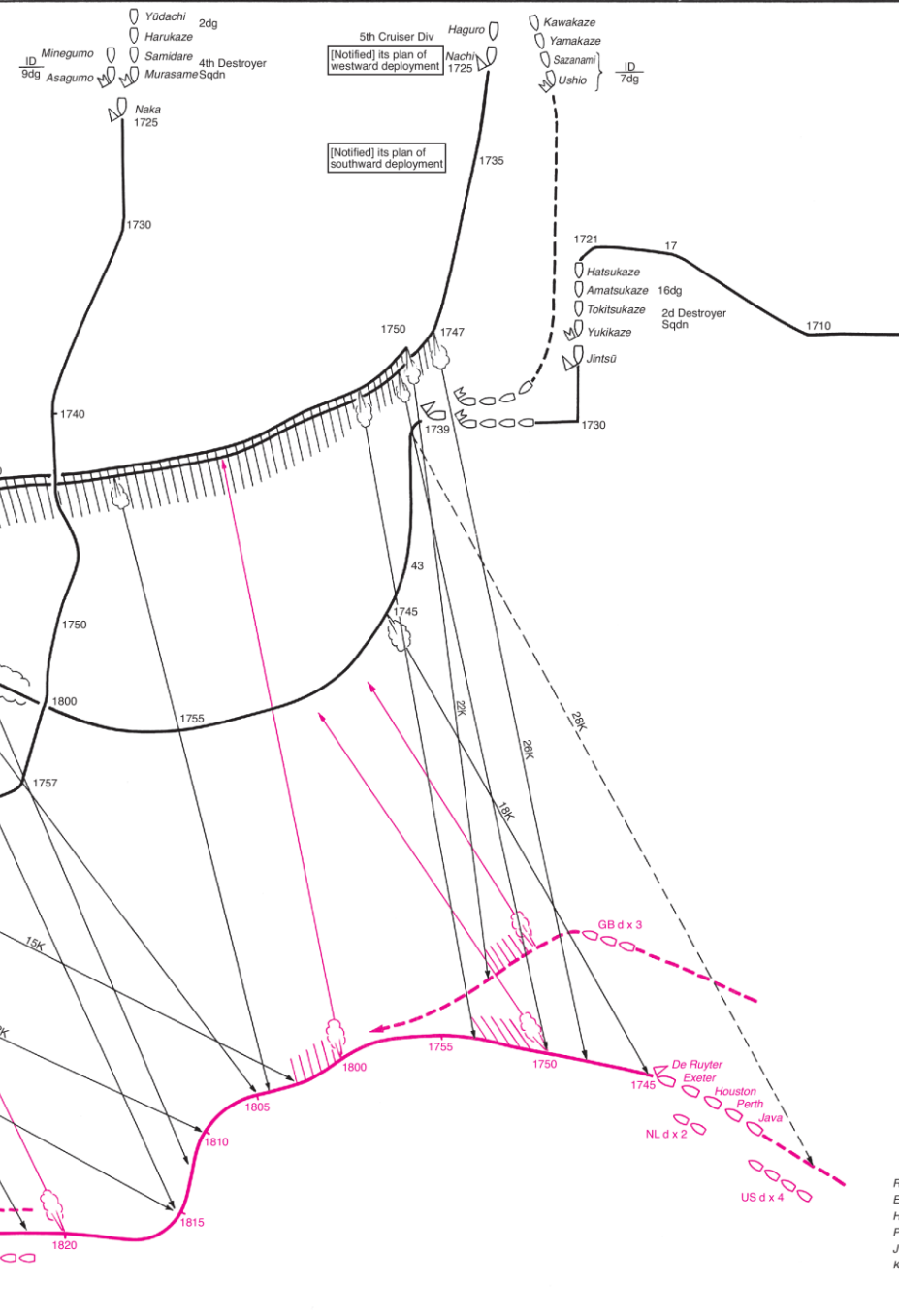
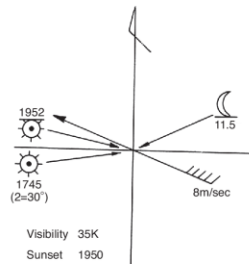

 - Direct hit



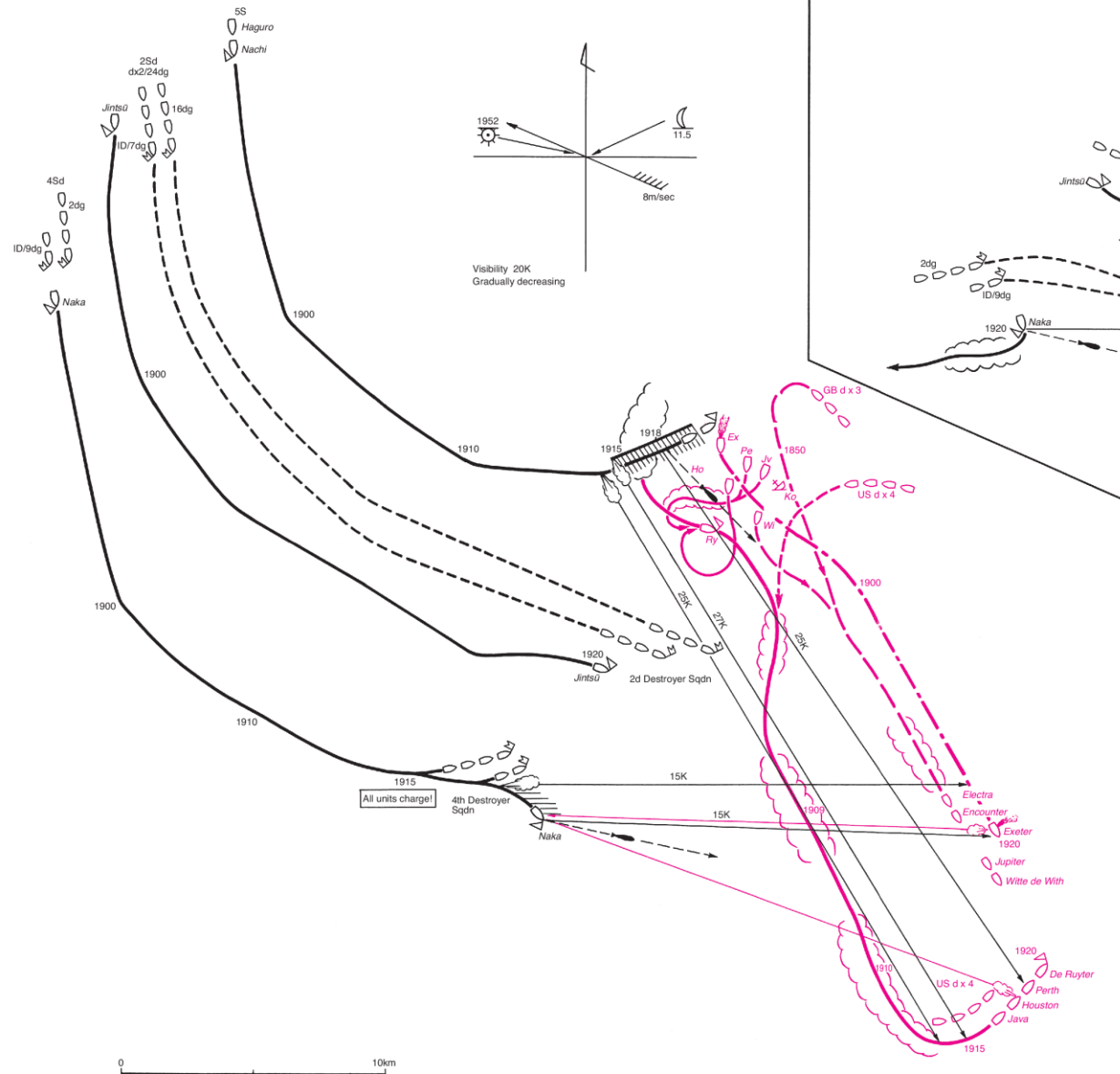

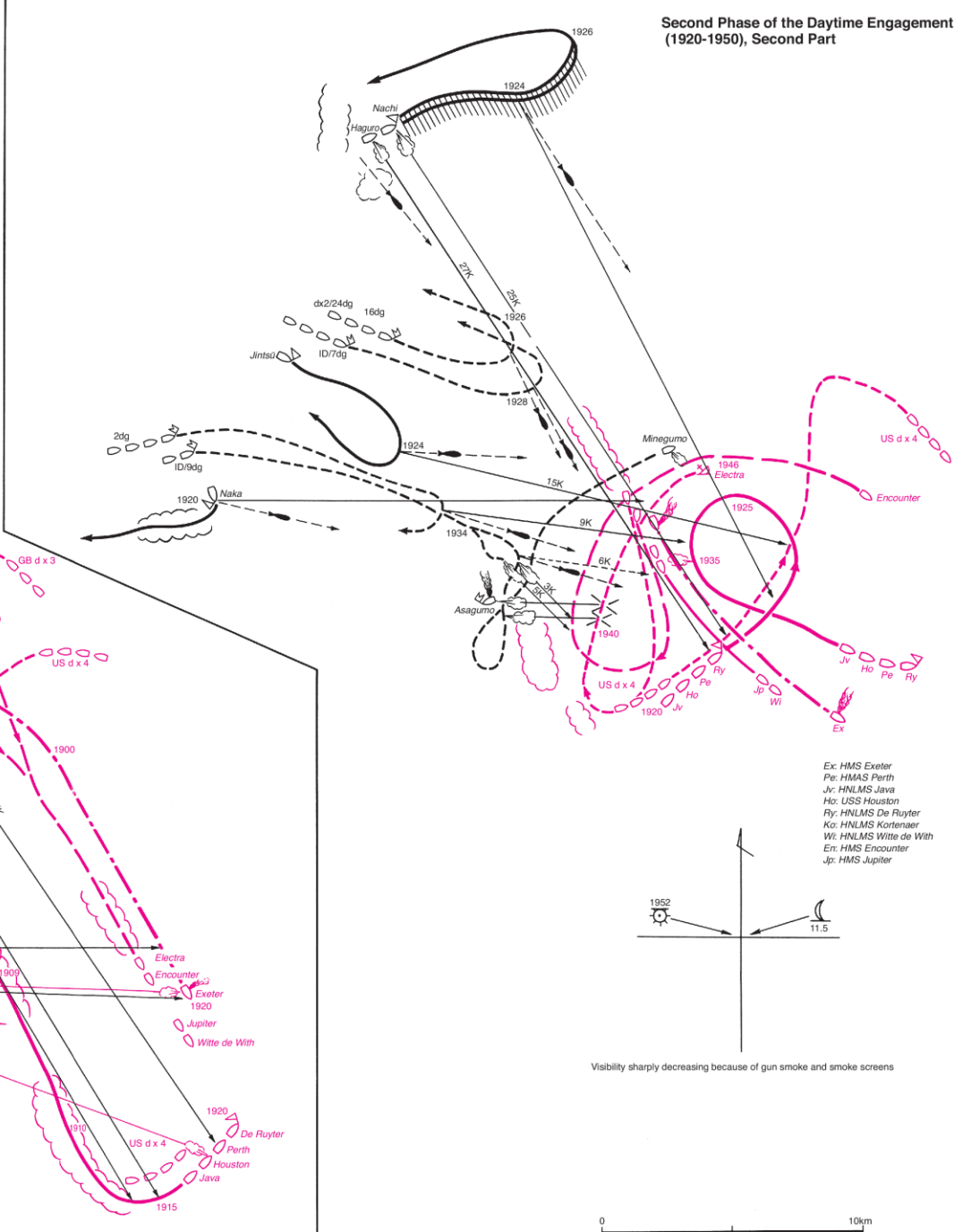

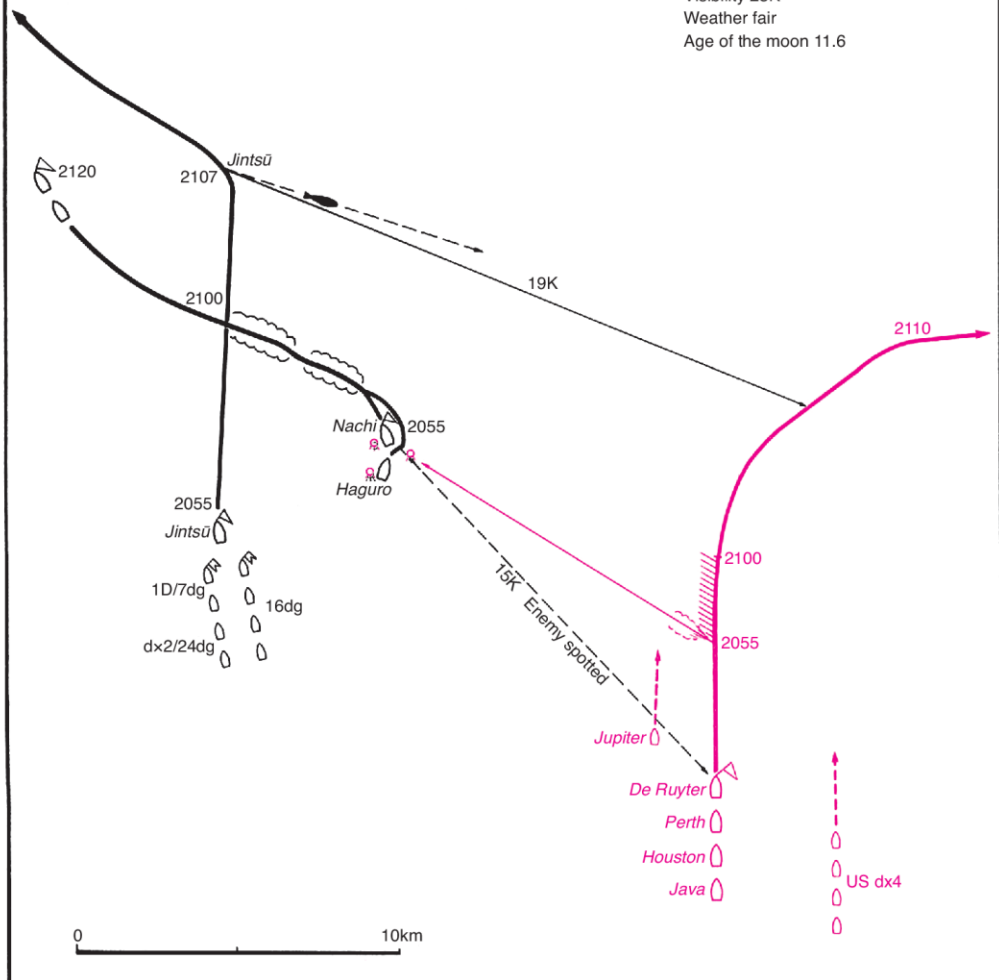
The Sea Engagement off Surabaya [Battle of the Java Sea] 27 February - 1 March 1942

(Based on the action reports of the 5th Cruiser Div, the 2d and the 4th Destroyer Sqdns)

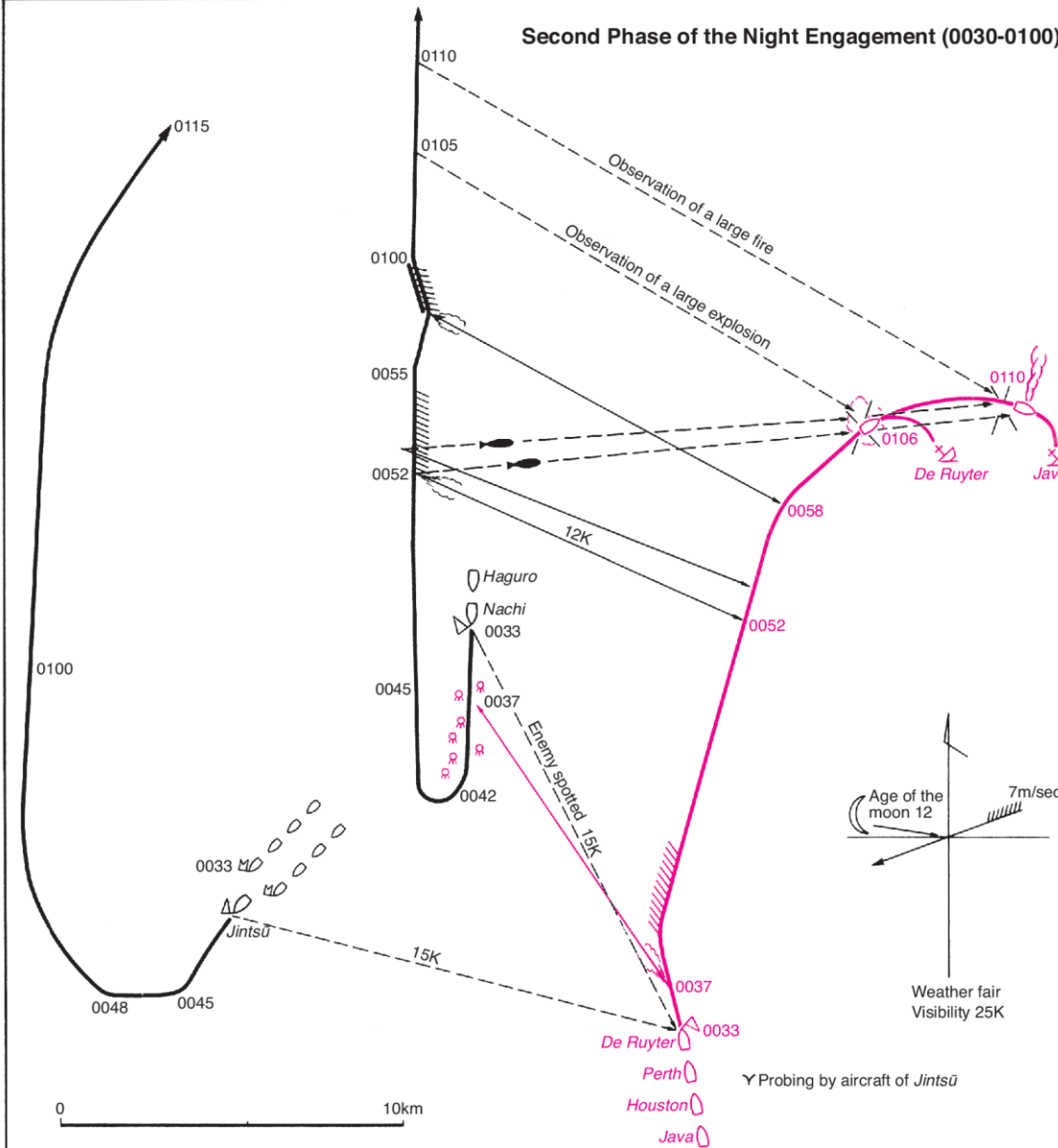


First Phase of the Night Engagement (2050-2110)
